Before choosing

- Read the Call for Applicants (choose the correct Department)
- Make sure the Host University offers your level (1 - Bachelor's; 2 - Master's; 3 - PhD)
- Make sure to consult the LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS of each host institution (last column to the right)

The study plan must be evaluated by the Professor and bear his/her signature as well as the student's signature otherwise it will be considered invalid!

The study plan must be attached to the application otherwise the application will be considered invalid!

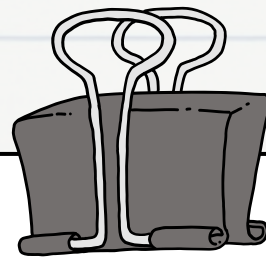

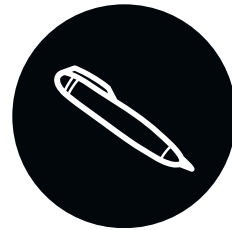

LANGUAGES

- Some host institutions may ask for additional language certificates!
- You should consult the CLA - University Language Center's FAQ's to see if you may be exempt from the language test and/or book the CLA language test



SPECIFIC EXAMS

- Be careful when choosing the exams you would like to transfer. Some may be more "universal" than others. For example, Language courses at Sapienza require a mandatory Lettorato component which may be specific to Sapienza.

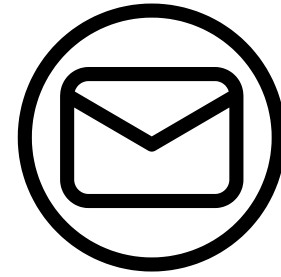


LEARNING AGREEMENT

- The Learning Agreement is a sort of Contract between the two Universities and it should contain at least 12 CFU (or at least 3 CFU if the project concerns research and development of the final thesis).
- The CHANGE FORM allows for subsequent modifications of the Agreement, don't worry!
