

CIVIS blended course

REFUGEES, MIGRANTS, AND EXILES IN GERMAN AND COMPARATIVE LITERATURE

In this course, **scholars in German and Comparative Literature from CIVIS universities** (Aix-Marseille, Athens, Brussels, Bucharest, Rome, Stockholm, Tübingen, Lausanne) and invited experts in the field share the results of their research: by studying literary texts, the students will learn about the **impacts and challenges of migration**. The course content will cover **diverse types of travellers** (refugees, migrants, exiles, expats), **questions of identity and community** (inter-/transculturality, belonging, integration, exclusion, diaspora, nomadism, cosmopolitanism), and **influences on language** (pluri- and multilingualism).

PRACTICAL DETAILS

- **Addressed to Master's students, PhD candidates and PhDs;**
- **Language: German (B2);**
- **6 ECTS** valid as Other Training Activities (AAF) or as German Literature course in Erasmus Learning Agreement;
- **Virtual seminars will be running from 11 February to 29 April 2025;**
- **Physical mobility: in-person workshop from 5 to 9 May 2025 in Bucharest.**
